- We used the identifiable victim effect to elicit animal advocacy among omnivores.
- We presented participants with identified or unidentified farm animal victim(s).
- An identified runaway calf, elicited greater reported and actual animal advocacy.
- The results extend previous work to helpers who are responsible to the victim's olight.
